You must live or work in the city of Loveland or be a member of a civic organization based in Loveland to be eligible. Please make sure you are committed to attending all 10 classes. Classes run from the beginning of September to November.

Classes start at 6:00 p.m. and conclude by 9:00 p.m. Classes are normally held on weekdays; however, special sessions may be held on Saturday morning. If you miss more than two classes during a session, you will not be able to graduate with your class.
